The Library of PTF

Our library was founded in 1919, at the same time as the Faculty started its activities. It provides services to the academic community and to the general public. It is possible to read our books in the library free of charge (even without registering).

The library offers

- » Extensive collections of books and journals in the fields of theology, religious studies, Jewish studies, philosophy, church history, and related disciplines (such as ethics, the humanities, and social work)
- » More than 120,000 volumes of specialist literature, including old printed books; newer titles are available in open access
- » Nearly 200 Czech and foreign journals, including e-journals
- » Bachelor's, master's, doctoral, and habilitation theses defended at PTF
- » A collection of manuscripts and old printed books numbering 2000 volumes
- » All the library's collections are accessible in the Faculty building in Černá street without having to be ordered

Catalogues

- » The library catalogue: includes books, journals, theses, articles from Czech theological journals, excerpts, reviews
- » Everything can be found in the Charles University search engine UKAŽ at <http://ukaz.cuni.cz>



Services

- » The library is open to the general public
- » All users can read our books in the library free of charge (even without registering)
- » Borrowing books, interlibrary loans, and literature searches are available to registered library readers
- » For Charles University students all the University libraries are accessible free of charge
- » The same reader's card is valid in all Charles University libraries
- » Library electronic resources can also be accessed at home
- » Access to electronic journals and books from foreign databases
- » Loan of e-books to mobile devices
- » Loan of e-book readers
- » Photocopying
- » Modern book scanner
- » Possibility to use self-service loan counter "self-check"
- » Possibility to renew loans and reserve books via the internet

Digitalisation centre

- » Possibility to order digitalisation of books, articles in journals, documents (contracts, records, price-lists, correspondence) and pictorial materials (analogue photos, postcards)
- » Digitalisation of documents requiring special care (old printed books, chronicles, etc.)
