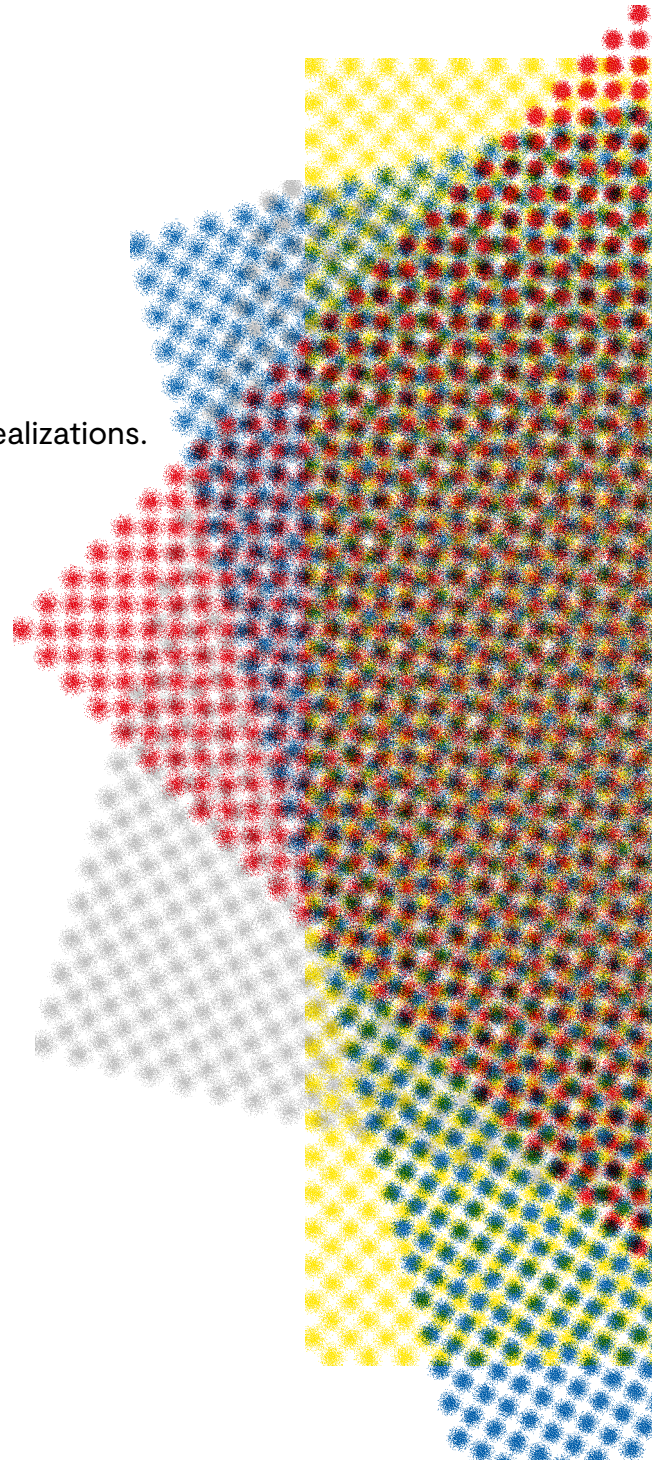
Title:

Summary:

Description of the project, character and course of presumed research work on the proposed project in the calendar year; possible outlook for following years. (500–1500 characters).

Previous activity:

Publications, exhibitions, didactic / artistic projects and realizations.





Entrance exam study project proposal

Current state of knowledge:

Indicate the current state of knowledge pertaining to the research topic and make references (citations) to relevant sources. It is appropriate to give the reasons / motivation for choosing your topic. It is appropriate to state whether this is the new, previously unresearched topic, or if existing research is unknown. This chapter should be the introduction to the project goals.

Range:

10 pages including references and Bibliography (15,000–18,000 characters).

Citation norm:

APA Style.

Explanation of relationships of the project with other projects:

Research questions:

1 main question, 2–3 incidental questions.

Research goals:

Project goals should be realistic and clearly formulated. They must be achievable within the proposed timeframe for the project. (4 years + 1 year for submission and defense of PhD thesis).

Methodology:

Describe your general idea of the research plan, including its distribution over 4 years.

Methodology and methods of research: describe your initial design.

Material resources for project:

Indicate whether the entire project will be researched at the Department of Art Education. Indicate the necessary equipment.

Presentation of results (dissemination):

Indicate how you expect to present the project results, especially in terms of publications, papers, conferences, journals, exhibitions etc.

How is your PhD project related to issues of your MA thesis? Indicate, describe.

Indicate a possible contribution of your PhD project to departmental research.

What would be your personal contribution to the departmental PhD community?
