


→ 6 main teaching hospitals (among which Pitié Salpêtrière, the biggest hospital in France, elected as the best hospital in France by Newsweek in 2021)







Organisation of medical studies

- **1st cycle** : Foundation year + 2 years of general training in medical sciences
- **2nd cycle**: 4th year to 6th year - advanced training in medical sciences
- **3rd cycle**: Specialization and PhD
- **Clinical rotations** are available from the 3rd year

The faculty of medicine

- **A dedicated International Office** is available to welcome international students and researchers

- **Accommodation:** some rooms are available for students who come for 1 semester minimum. Assistance to find a room is provided for short mobility



Life in Paris- looks expensive but..

- Public transports: €350 per year (50% refund for hospital placements)
- Hospital placements are paid:
€208/ €257/ €313 per month
- Student meal: €3.30 per meal at CROUS



Typical day schedule for Erasmus+ student in medicine:

9 a.m. – 12 a.m.: clinical rotation (940h/27 weeks full time per year)

2 p.m. – 6 p.m.: theoretical courses – not compulsory





Extracurricular activities:

- French as foreign language: online or not
- Sports, theatre...
- Student associations' activities
- Free entrance to 30 public museums
