
Concert: Requiem aeternam

Let us invite you to a concert Requiem Aeternam, organised by Heidelberg and Charles University. Concert takes place in St. Ursula Church on 21. of July and starts in 18:15.

The concert is to commemorate the victims of the Thirty Years' War, which devastated the society with one third of the population vanished and with substantial economical damage and poverty.
