The main theme of the conference will be devoted to the issue of education of citizenship and values in divided times from the perspective of building bonds through values. Identifying positive mechanisms that promote cohesion is often seen as a priority for building sustainable communities and recognizing the importance of values in helping to deepen these ties. Citizenship education provides practical opportunities to explore particular identities and their conflicts with each other.

Submissions dealing with related secondary topics are also welcome, such as:

- How and in what ways can citizenship education encourage young people to engage within their communities in today's divided times.
- How educators and other stakeholders perceive and use civic education for building connections through values, youth identities and forms of active citizenship.

We also welcome contributors focusing on any aspects of citizenship education and values from around the world, exploring curriculum development, pedagogy or the psychology of youth identity, civic education and learning, human rights or history education.
